### **Continuing Education Credits**

All educational sessions are approved for category A or A+ credit by the American Society of Radiologic Technologists (A.S.R.T.). Applicable sessions are also approved by the Medical Dosimetry Certification Board (M.D.C.B.). In order to receive appropriate documentation for credit, you are required to bring your CE Documentation Form to every education session. Write your name on the CE Documentation Form. The reference number for each session will be announced at the end of the session and you must write the reference number on the duplicate form in the appropriate space. The reference number will be announced only once so please pay careful attention.

Because most educational sessions are 50 minutes in length, you are not permitted to enter or leave the room once the presentation begins. Hence, use your comfort breaks between sessions wisely and plan accordingly. If you wish to enter late or leave early, then you will not receive credit for the session and the room moderator will mark your CE Documentation Form in the appropriate space with the words "No Credit" and then initial the space.

After attending your final session and before leaving for home, place the bottom copy of the duplicate form in the basket at the rear of the room or in the registration area, and then keep the top copy for your records. This allows the O.S.R.T. to keep a record of your attendance at educational sessions. According to A.S.R.T. policy, A.S.R.T. members are responsible for submitting their CE Documentation Form to the A.S.R.T. Sessions approved for A+ credit are designated with an plus (+) symbol.
