It is hard to believe the holidays will soon be upon us. You know what that means...long lines, expanding waistlines, and shrinking wallets! While we may not be able to help with the long lines or your waistline, we can help with your shrinking wallet. Whether you are a student struggling to make your way or a student struggling to juggle a family, we understand times are tough financially. That is why I would like to take this opportunity to make you aware of several scholarship and grant opportunities made available from OSRT as well as the OSRT Educational and Research Foundation.

The first opportunity is the Professional Poster Competition. The subject of the poster should be either a clinical application or research category. According to the rules listed on the OSRT website, a clinical application poster should demonstrate a new position, method, or





application or an improvement on an existing one. Eligibility requirements include being enrolled in an approved medical imaging or radiologic science program, being an OSRT member, and being present at the OSRT Annual meeting which will be held April 13-17, 2011 in Columbus, Ohio. Interested students and technologists must submit the online application for this award by **February 1, 2011.** 

A second opportunity is the OSRT Essay Competition. According to the essay rules, the subject of the essay should be "pertinent to medical imaging or radiologic science, have current or future educational or technical value and follow the criteria listed on the essay judging criteria sheets.' Students and technologists interested in the essay contest must submit electronically the completed application along with the essay by February 1, 2011.

A third opportunity is the OSRT Educational and Research Foundation Grant sponsored by the OSRT Educational and Research Foundation. The grant is based on merit, academic ability, and financial need and is due **February 1**, 2011.
