Volunteer Service Program

Thank you for your interest in serving the OSRT and giving back to the profession! The following committees and appointments are areas of the OSRT where volunteer service is open to any OSRT member. If you are interested in submitting a request for service in any of these areas, please return to the OSRT Web page and follow the directions for submitting your request. Committee appointments are made by the incoming OSRT President, with each appointment beginning in October and ending in September of the next year.

Advocacy Committee

This committee monitors state and federal legislative activities, as well as ASRT grassroots advocacy efforts. Committee members attend meetings for the following Ohio Department of Health Committees: the Radiation Generating Equipment Committee and the Radiation Advisory Council. Committee members can also be involved in contacting legislators via email or phone to discuss healthcare issues and bills, and assist with RT at Capitol days. This committee consists of 4-6 members in addition to the Chair and Vice Chair.

Time Commitment: Committee members may spend four hours monthly on a rotating basis attending Radiation Generating Equipment Meeting and an additional four hours monthly dedicated to ASRT grass-roots advocacy efforts.

Annual Meeting Committee

The Annual Meeting Committee oversees and coordinates all aspects of the Annual Meeting. This includes working with hotel/venue management, submitting speaker documentation for CE approval, formatting the event schedule, and collaborating with other committees and appointees (education, Ohio Society of Radiologic Technologists Education and Research Foundation, and Operations Manager). This committee typically consists of 5-6 members, including the Chair and Vice Chair.

Time Commitment: Approximately eight hours per month for one year prior to the Annual Meeting. Committee members are expected to attend the entire Annual Meeting.

Education Committee

The Education Committee is responsible for offering continuing education sessions and workshops, which could be in-person or virtual. Committee members must make arrangements for meeting location, speaker assignments, submission of requests for CE approval, attendee sign-in and welcome, and scheduling meal functions and menu as needed. This committee usually consists of 6-8 committee members in addition to the Chair and Vice Chair.

Time Commitment: Approximately five hours per month.

Marketing and Sales Committee

The Marketing and Sales Committee works with the Annual Meeting and SES Committees to develop a list of sponsors, vendors, and donors for OSRT events. This committee also researches potential vendors who may be interested in advertising on the OSRT Website. This committee consists of 4-6 members in addition to the Chair and Vice Chair.

Time Commitment: Four to eight hours per month.

Membership Committee

The Membership Committee was developed to focus attention on increasing student and technologist membership across all modalities. This committee also reviews bylaws related to membership, suggesting revisions to the Board of Directors. They also research additional potential benefits for members, making formal recommendations to the Board of Directors. This committee consists of 6-8 members in addition to the Chair and Vice Chair.

Time Commitment: Two to four hours per month.

Nominating Committee

The Nominating Committee solicits candidates for the Board of Directors election slate, the Technologist of the Year Award, and Life Membership. The committee ensures that candidates meet the requirements to serve in their desired position or for the nominated award. The committee prepares the OSRT ballot and counts the votes for the Board of Directors election and for the Technologist of the Year Award. A formal motion is sent to the Board of Directors for the consideration of a technologist for Life Membership. This committee comprises five members, including the Chair and Vice Chair. Ideally, one member should be from each of the following regions of Ohio: northwest, northeast, central, southwest, and southeast.

Time Commitment: One to two hours per month.

Quiz Bowl Committee

The Quiz Bowl Committee revises all quiz bowl questions, updates the team application in collaboration with the Webmaster, creates the competition brackets, and develops the competition question rounds, including extra and tie-breaker questions. The committee also solicits volunteer moderators, judges, scorekeepers, and sergeant-at-arms, and provides all necessary information to the designated volunteers. This committee works collaboratively with the OSRT Operations Manager to determine team member eligibility.

Time Commitment: Committee members meet two to three times per year for a minimum of three hours each. Volunteers are required to attend the advisor meeting and the entire Quiz Bowl competition at the Annual Meeting. (Set-up takes about two hours, and the competition about eight hours.) This committee consists of 8-10 committee members in addition to the Chair and Vice Chair.

Student and Educator Symposium (SES) Committee

The SES Committee oversees and coordinates all aspects of the Student and Educator Symposium. This includes working with hotel management, submitting speaker documentation for CE approval, formatting the event schedule, and collaborating with other committees and appointees (quiz bowl, education, honors, Ohio Society of Radiologic Technologists Education and Research Foundation, and Operations Manager). This committee usually consists of 8-12 members, including the Chair, Vice-Chair, and Apprentice, all of whom are Board members.

Time Commitment: Approximately sixteen hours per month for one year prior to the SES. Committee members are expected to attend the entire SES.
