

ADVOCACY DAY

On October 29th, representatives from the OSRT and the organization's legislative agent, Paul Kudlak, had individual meetings with several state senators, representatives, and their staff at the Ohio Statehouse to discuss critical issues impacting patient care and the radiologic technology profession.

During these conversations, OSRT members emphasized the vital role radiologic technologists play in delivering safe, high-quality, and timely imaging and therapy services for patients across Ohio. As the recognized experts in medical imaging and radiation therapy, technologists ensure accuracy, safety, and adherence to best practices.



Special attention was given to the importance of proactive advocacy, given recent concerns about potential infringements of supervision policies and the scope of practice by non-imaging professionals, including nurse practitioners. OSRT leaders stressed that maintaining clear professional boundaries is essential to protect patient safety and uphold the integrity of imaging and therapy services.



The event reinforced OSRT's commitment to legislative engagement and its mission to safeguard radiologic technologists' standards of practice. By continuing these conversations and educational opportunities, the OSRT ensures that patient care remains in the hands of qualified professionals educated to deliver excellence.





Please consider submitting a nomination for the Ohio Society of Radiologic Technologists Board of Directors. **Nominations for Director-at-Large (September 2026- September 2029 term), President-Elect, Technologist of the Year, and Life Member are now open through May 15!**

Qualification requirements, expectations, and additional information are available on the [OSRT website](#).

Candidates for Director are expected to:

- Attend the Leadership Academy, if not previously attended, on June 20
- Attend the Annual Meeting, September 24-26
- Attend all Board meetings during the term of office.
- Chair, vice-chair, or be an apprentice on a committee during the term of office
- Participate in additional committee work
- Committee meetings are held at the discretion of the chairperson and are generally conducted face-to-face or virtually
- Term commitment is three years.

FELLOW PROGRAM OF THE OSRT: THE MARK OF EXCELLENCE!

Qualifications for fellowship include a history of active OSRT membership, significant contributions through leadership roles, committee service, education, research, or professional advocacy, and a clear record of mentoring or supporting the growth of others. Candidates exemplify high ethical standards and a commitment to advancing radiologic science and professional practice. Fellowship is awarded through a peer review and nomination process, underscoring the respect and recognition of colleagues across Ohio.
